- i) A collection of related data or program records
- j) Set of keys used to operate a computer
- k) Portable computer
- I) Small device used to place the cursor
- m) Location on the Internet where information can be supplied and obtained
- n) To insert (copied text, images, etc.) into a file
- o) To store data
